Training based on current DGR IATA (Dangerous Goods Regulations).

 **Duration** for information purposes

4 hrs.

Prerequisites

For recurrent training: initial training Dangerous Goods-Category 17 completed less than two years old.

Method

- Theoretical course in classroom.
- A qualified and experienced trainer provides the training action.

Evaluation

- **Theoretical** : Written validation final test (minimum 80% pass mark required).

Validity

Maximum 2 years (IATA / Dangerous Goods Regulations). Recurrent training must be provided within 24 months of previous training to ensure knowledge is current.
